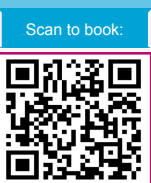

WHO WILL BENEFIT FROM THE PROGRAMME?

HOW LONG IS THIS PROGRAMME FOR?

CORE PRECEPTORSHIP:

12-month support with 6 sessions spaced out over the course of the year (months 1, 2, 3, 6, 9, and 12)

Blended learning experience: face-to-face workshops, workplace learning, pastoral support, coaching from senior staff members.

BEYOND PRECEPTORSHIP:

6 flexible days within the 12th to 24th month
